As of July 22nd, Coronavirus cases reach 8,720 total cases, including 201 deaths and 5,105 recoveries.

As of July 20th, there are 60 total cases of Ebola in Western DRC. According to WHO, this new outbreak has "no common viral strain" with the earlier epidemic in Ituri and North Kivu in the East, which has since been declared over.
